The imported wastes should be accompanied by a certificate of analysis and examination issued by an internationally accredited bodies and labs. In addition, samples of the imported wastes could be analysed and tested by the Egyptian General Organization of Export and import Control (GOEIC) in order to prove that the extent to which those wastes are free of prohibited injurious contaminations. Further information on "other control procedures" can be found in the executive regulation of export and import law No 118 for the year 1975, issued by the Ministerial degree No 770 for the year 2005. Furthermore, those procedures can be found in executive decisions organizing technical work in (GOEIC).
