The Law of Georgia "On Import Export and Transit of waste" regulates the transboundary movement of wastes. It is allowed to import only nonhazardous waste (a few type of nonhazardous waste) for recovery operations, the import requires permission from Ministry of Environmental Protection and Agriculture, the procedures and necessary documentation is given by above mentioned law.

Since 2016 year in Georgia waste is classified by Basel convention code and national waste codes (similar as EU list of waste). If the animal waste is not classified under Basel convention they are out of law on import export and transit of waste as well as governmental decree. In this case they will be under regulation of governmental decree N605 (29.12.2017) the Technical Regulation - " on animal origin non-food products (including animal waste) and secondary products not intended for human consumption, the rules of recognition of the health and related business operator related to these activities"
